Hallo!, Tag!, and Grüß dich! all are ways of saying ‘Hello’ or ‘Hi.’ Although *Hallo!* is commonly heard throughout Germany, *Grüß dich!* is more often heard in southern Germany and *Tag!* in the rest of the country. All three are informal greetings that are used among friends, young people and relatives. Additional FORMAL greetings that can be heard for ‘Hello’ are *Grüß Gott!* in southern Germany and *Guten Tag!* in other parts of the country.

Tschüss! or Tschau! is a casual form of *Auf Wiedersehen!*, meaning ‘good-bye.’ It’s quite common to drop the first word and say *Wiedersehen!*
