- I. Can draw, label & fill in both the 'ein-chart' & 'adjectives after ein-chart'
- II. Know the German words (including the articles) for these items from a German menu: \*the menu \*the appetizer(s) \*the side dish(es) \*the main course \*the dessert \*the tip \*the beverage(s)

## **III.** Formal Commands:

- \*Be able to explain the rules of how to form a formal German command \*Be able to create THREE different (each with a different verb) commands each for what you might hear in the following settings:
  - → 3 commands a teenager might hear at home from a parent
  - → 3 commands a student might hear at school from a teacher
  - → 3 commands that might be used in a restaurant

## IV. Expressing Preferences (using 'lieber' correctly)

\*Be able to explain the rules of where 'lieber' goes in a question/sentence \*If given choices between two things, be able to express preference by using 'lieber' in a sentence.

- → Example: Bratkartoffeln oder Salzkartoffeln essen?
- → Example: den Tisch abräumen oder dein Zimmer aufräumen?

(note...the verbs used above are just examples – not ones from test)

## V. 'Was für' (What kind of...) & 'noch ein/e/en; noch mehr'

- \*Know how to use with nouns that are 'der'; 'die' (fem); 'das' and plural \*Can explain why/how saying 'What kind of...' is different with plurals \*Know how to use the expression 'noch ein/e/en or noch mehr' to talk about 'another' or 'more' of something.
- VI. Know the adjective AFTER 'ein-word' chart & how to use it.
  - \*On Mid-Unit Assessment, you will be given sentences you will have to label the nom/acc/dat and ALSO if items are mas/fem/neu/plural and then use the CORRECT chart (ein-word & adjective AFTER ein-word chart)
