- A. Know all vocabulary from the Unit 2 Vocabulary lists
  - 1. Know all fruits & vegetables covered; know all table-setting items; restaurant vocab
- B. <u>MENU VOCABULARY</u> (the menu; beverage/s; appetizer/s; side dish/es; dessert; the main course)
  - 1. Also know the German names for the traditional German foods covered in class
- C. FORMAL COMMANDS know the rules for forming formal commands
- D. GERN / LIEBER
- E. <u>PRESENT PERFECT</u> (SPOKEN PAST TENSE)
  - 1. Know what two things are needed in all present perfect sentences and where they go
  - 2. Know how to form the past participles of regular verbs; which have +t or +et at the end
  - 3. Know how to form the past participles of sep. verbs (e.g. ausführen/einladen)
  - 4. Know which kind of verbs can NOT add a ge- to them to form the past participle
  - 5. Must memorize the Present Perfect forms of all 51 forms on the irregular verbs list
  - 6. Especially know which verbs take a form of 'sein' as their helping verb
- F. 'WAS FŰR' know the ways of expressing 'What kind of..' (Was für einen/eine/ein/--)
- G. 'ANOTHER' noch ein / noch eine / noch einen / noch mehr....
- H. CONJUNCTIONS
  - 1. Coordinating Conjunctions (aber; denn; oder; und) verb order rules (incl. past tense)
  - 2. Subordinating Conjunctions (weil; wenn; dass; ob) verb order rules
- I. EIN-CHART / ADJECTIVE AFTER EIN-WORDS CHART
  - 1. Will need to know how to find nominative/accusative/dative to apply the charts
- J. <u>PRONOUNS</u>:
  - 1. Must know all pronouns (Nom/Acc/Dat) and the possessive forms (e.g. ich/mich/mir/mein)
  - 2. How to replace nouns with correct pronoun form. (Ich kenne den Mann. = Ich kenne <u>ihn</u>).
- K. <u>PREPOSITIONS</u>
  - 1. Know all accusative prepositions / definitions (durch; für; gegen; ohne; um)
  - 2. Know all dative prepositions / definitions (aus;  $au\beta er$ ; bei; mit; nach; seit; von; zu)
  - To properly apply the prepositions, must also know all charts covered (der-; ein-; Adjective after ein-; pronouns)
